CHAPTER 71-254

Conference Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 625

AN ACT relating to limitation of actions; amending section 95.11 (6), Florida Statutes, to provide that actions to recover damages for injuries to the person arising out of any medical, dental, optometric, podiatric or chiropractic treatment or surgical operation must be brought within two (2) years; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (6) of section 95.11, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

95.11 Limitations upon actions other than real actions.—Actions other than those for the recovery of real property can only be commenced as follows:

(6) WITHIN TWO YEARS.—An action by another than the state upon a statute for a penalty or forfeiture; an action for libel, slander, assault, battery or false imprisonment; an action arising upon account of an act causing a wrongful death; *an action to recover damages for injuries to the person arising from any medical, dental, optometric, podiatric or chiropractic treatment or surgical operation, the cause of action in such case not to be deemed to have accrued until the plaintiff discovers, or through use of reasonable care should have discovered, the injury.*

Section 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 1972.

CHAPTER 71-255

Senate Bill No. 663

AN ACT relating to public schools; amending section 232.25, Florida Statutes; relating to pupils subject to control of school, to delete provisions providing for control while students are en route to school except by school bus, or control at time student is presumably attending school; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 232.25, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

232.25 Pupils subject to control of school.—Subject to law and rules and regulations of the state board and of the school board, each pupil enrolled in a school shall, during the time he is being transported to or from school at public expense, ~~during the time he is otherwise en route to or from school~~, during the time he is attending ~~or is presumed by law to be attending~~ school, and during the time he is on the school premises, be under the control and direction of the principal or teacher in charge of the school, and under the immediate control and direction of the teacher or other member of the instructional staff or of the bus driver to whom such responsibility may be assigned by the principal. *However, the state board or the district school board may, by rules and regulations, subject each pupil to the control and direction of the principal or teacher in charge of the school during the time he is otherwise en route to or from school or is presumed by law to be attending school.*

Section 2. This act shall become effective on July 1, 1971.
