Chapter 86-272

Legislative History

Chapter 86-272 officially originated as H.B. 832, however, the language amending the subject section was not part of the bill as originally filed, which dealt only with the reduction of the statute of limitations on actions for libel or slander. The language amending §95.031 actually originated with a pair of similar bills, designated S.B. 821 and H.B. 944, which were referred to the Senate Committee on Commerce and the House Committee on the Judiciary, respectively.

The two bills started out as identical, but the committee substitutes for each differed significantly (see *items 52 and 56*). It was the text of CS/HB 944 which was amended onto CS/HB 832 when it reached the House floor on June 5, 1986 (see *item 50*).

Findings

I examined in the Florida State Archives the 1986 files of the two committees mentioned above. The records of both committees appeared to be complete and in good order.

Section 10. The legislative draft of the coastal management program submitted to the Legislature by the department dated March 1, 1978, and the previously prepared coastal zone atlases are expressly rejected as the state's coastal management program. The department shall not divide areas of the state into vital, conservation and development areas.

Section 11. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared severable.

Section 12. This act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

CHAPTER 78-288

Senate Bill No. 4-D

AN ACT relating to marketable record titles to real property; adding s. 712.03(7), Florida Statutes; providing an exception to marketability for sovereignty lands; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (7) is added to section 712.03, Florida Statutes, to read:

712.03 Exceptions to marketability.--Such marketable record title shall not affect or extinguish the following rights:

(7) State title to lands beneath navigable waters acquired by virtue of its sovereignty.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

CHAPTER 78-289

Senate Bill No. 5-D

AN ACT relating to limitations of civil actions; adding s. 95.031(3), Florida Statutes; providing for the computation of time for the period of limitations for causes of action involving sovereignty lands; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) is added to section 95.031, Florida Statutes, to read:

95.031 Computation of time.--Except as provided in subsection 95.051(2) and elsewhere in these statutes, the time within which an action shall be begun under any statute of limitations runs from the time the cause of action accrues.

(3) No cause of action on behalf of the state for conversion of property severed from, for trespass upon, or for other unauthorized use or invasion of state-owned lands, including sovereignty lands, shall be barred by any provision of this chapter.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, and shall expire July 1, 1980.

CHAPTER 78-290

Senate Bill No. 114

AN ACT relating to public school construction; amending s. 235.26(2)(e), Florida Statutes, and adding a new paragraph (f) to said subsection; providing for the development of an energy performance index to serve as a measure of building performance with respect to energy consumption; providing for life-cycle cost analyses with respect to alternative architectural and engineering designs; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (e) of subsection (2) of section 235.26, Florida Statutes, is amended and paragraph (f) is added to said subsection to read:

235.26 State Uniform Building Code for Public Educational Facilities Construction.--The office is directed to recommend to the state board for approval rules prescribing a mandatory, uniform, statewide building code for the construction of public educational facilities. The office shall recommend and the state board shall adopt, as part of the State Uniform Building Code for public school construction, flood plain management criteria in compliance with the rules and regulations at 24 C.F.R., Parts 1909-1925, established by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development pursuant to 42 U.S.C. ss. 4001-4128. Wherever the words "Uniform Building Code" appear, they shall mean the "State Uniform Building Code for Public Educational Facilities Construction." It shall not be the intent of the Uniform Building Code to inhibit the use of new materials or innovative techniques; nor shall it specify or prohibit materials by brand names. The code shall be flexible enough to cover all phases of construction which will afford reasonable protection for public safety, health, and general welfare. The office may secure the service of other state agencies or such other assistance as it may find desirable in the revision of the code.
