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A bill to be entitled

An act relating to Palm Beach County; amending section 1 of chapter 59-994, Laws of Florida, to include specified parcels of land in the territorial limits of the Northern Palm Beach County Water Control District; adding additional powers of the district for water supply, sewer and wastewater management, waste collection and disposal, street lights, control of arthropods and to supply and level water within the district; authorizing the issuance of revenue bonds and bond anticipation notes; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 59-994, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapters 63-1744, 80-570, 81-461, and 84-498, Laws of Florida, is amended by adding additional paragraphs to the end of said section as follows:

The territorial limits of the Northern Palm Beach
County Water Control District shall also embrace and include

I. SUMMARY OF BILL:

The bill amends section 1 of chapter 59-994, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapters 63-1744, 80-570, 81-461, and 84-498, Laws of Florida, to expand the territorial boundaries of the Northern Palm Beach County Water Control District. The bill also provides the district with the power to plan, establish, acquire, construct, operate, and maintain systems and facilities for:

- (1) Water supply, sewer, or wastewater management;
- (2) Waste collection and disposal or effluent disposal;
- (3) Street lights for public roads;
- (4) Control and elimination of mosquitoes and other arthropods;
- (5) Water level maintenance, including the movement of water from one waterbody to another;
- (6) Control of the development and use of natural or artificial waterbodies; and
- (7) Prevention and alleviation of land erosion.

The district also is provided with the power to issue revenue bonds and bond anticipation notes to pay for the various systems and facilities.

II. AMENDMENTS:

There are two amendments to the bill. The first amendment deletes the existing language on bond issuance and inserts additional language pertaining to procedures for issuing bonds to pay for the systems and facilities listed in the bill. The second amendment adds Page 2

language stating that nothing in the section granting additional powers to the district is to be construed to preempt any of the local government comprehensive plan (chapter 163) consistency requirements for water and sewer development. The amendment requires that systems or facilities for water supply, sewer, and wastewater management established under the act shall comply with all applicable land development regulations or ordinances.
