H 599 GENERAL BILL/CS/1ST ENG by Rules & Calendar; Community Affairs; C.F. Jones (Similar CS/CS/S 566, S 764, Compare CS/H 600, CS/CS/H 637, CS/CS/CS/H 1304, CS/2ND ENG/S 484, S 771)
Special Districts; creates Uniform Special District Accountability Act of 1989; provides statutory requirements for special districts; provides for preparation of official list of special districts; provides for independent & dependent special district creation; provides for special district merger; provides for collection of non-ad valorem assessments; provides for special district bond referenda; creates Special District Information Program, etc. Amends F.S. Appropriation: \$214,000. Effective Date: 10/01/89 except as otherwise provided.
