H 1063 GENERAL BILL/1ST ENG by Sansom and others (Similar S 747)

Maritime Criminal Jurisdiction; provides for state special maritime criminal jurisdiction; delimits circumstances under which said jurisdiction shall apply; provides applicability of criminal penalties; stipulates enforcement limitations. Creates 910.006. Effective Date: 10/01/89.
