S 896 GENERAL BILL/CS/2ND ENG by Insurance; Insurance
(Similar CS/1ST ENG/H 1767, Compare CS/H 811, H 1254, H 1357,
H 1630, S 943, 1ST ENG/S 1324)

Workers' Compensation/Revisions; excludes certain education & training of injured employees from definition of "contractual services"; provides certain access to HIV test results; defines "construction industry" & "misconduct"; defines "employment" re construction industry; provides for benefit reduction for failure to use provided safety equipment; provides limitation on disability benefits for certain professional athletes, etc. Amends F.S. Appropriation: \$2,853,403. Effective Date: 10/01/89 except as otherwise provided.
