**H 1029 GENERAL BILL/CS/1ST ENG by Criminal Justice; Silver; Renke and others (Similar S 920)**  
~~Crimes Against Elderly/Sentencing~~; provides enhanced criminal penalties for aggravated assault or aggravated battery, battery, or assault against elderly person, including mandatory sentencing, fine, & restitution; reclassifies certain crimes; prohibits withholding adjudication. Creates 784.08. Effective Date: 10/01/89.
