**H 1427 GENERAL BILL/CS/1ST ENG by Regulatory Reform; D.L. Jones (Compare CS/H 393, CS/H 648, CS/H 700, H 845, CS/H 888, CS/H 934, H 1098, CS/H 1324, CS/H 1432, H 1436, CS/H 1448, CS/1ST ENG/H 1521, 1ST ENG/S 255, CS/S 510, CS/S 561, CS/S 627, CS/S 656, 1ST ENG/S 675, S 922, S 1065, 1ST ENG/S 1114, CS/S 1121, CS/S 1135, S 1150, CS/S 1212, CS/1ST ENG/S 1213, CS/S 1428)**

**Professional Regulation (OMNIBUS);** requires annual, rather than biennial, registration of dental laboratories; provides grounds for disciplinary action re practice of medicine; prohibits sexual misconduct in practice of osteopathic medicine; requires certain persons who are carriers of hepatitis B virus to notify Dentistry Bd.; provides for inspection of direct disposal establishments; conforms provisions re inspection of funeral establishments, etc. Amends F.S. Effective Date: 10/01/89.
