H 1460 GENERAL BILL/CS by Community Affairs; Rehm; Drage; C.F. Jones (Similar 1ST ENG/H 21-B, Compare H 1273, CS/S 699, S 777, S 838)

Developments of Regional Impact; (THIS BILL COMBINES H 1460,1273) modifies conditions for preliminary development agreements; provides for consistency with State Comprehensive Plan for certain developments; modifies procedure for review & issuance of development orders under Fla. Quality Developments program; provides for appeal of development orders; provides an exemption for siting of state correctional facilities, etc. Amends 380.06,.061,.0651, 944.095. Effective Date: 07/06/89.
