

I. SUMMARY:

A. Present Situation:

A portion of State Road 60 in Hillsborough County beginning at Falkenburg Road and extending 6.61 miles to Mt. Carmel Road is not named.

B. Effect of Proposed Changes:

The bill designates the 6.61-mile portion on State Road 60 in Hillsborough County as "Brandon Boulevard." The bill directs the Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.
