I. SUMMARY:

A. Present Situation:

Mr. Scott Linder is a distinguished alumnus of the University of Florida. Since graduation he has held the following offices: past president of the Florida Chamber of Commerce, chairman of the Florida Council on Economic Education and the Florida Council of 100, and current vice president of the University of Florida Foundation. Mr. Linder has been a longtime financial supporter of the university's National Merit Scholars Program, the department of civil engineering, the Manning J. Davis Lecture Series, the Howe Rare Book Collection Fund, and men's and women's intercollegiate athletics, particularly tennis. Mr. Linder's financial contributions to tennis have provided the University of Florida with one of the nation's finest campus tennis facilities.

B. Effect of Proposed Changes:

The proposed bill would name the tennis courts and varsity tennis facility at the University of Florida the "Scott Linder Tennis Stadium." It would also direct the University of Florida to erect suitable markers identifying the building.
