I. SUMMARY:

A. Present Situation:

The new Florida Highway Patrol Troop E Headquarters located at 1011 N.W. 11th Avenue in Miami, Florida, was dedicated to the memory of Trooper Alphonso Lofton on August 19th, 1988.

B. Effect of Proposed Changes:

The bill directs the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to name the Florida Highway Patrol Troop E Headquarters in Miami as the Trooper Alphonso Lofton Highway Patrol Station and to erect markers bearing that designation.

II. ECONOMIC IMPACT AND FISCAL NOTE:

A. Public:

B. Government:

The plaque designating the building was donated and will be installed at a later date. There will be no cost to the state.

III. COMMENTS:

Trooper Lofton was employed with the department on May 1, 1970, and was the first black Florida Highway patrolman. He was the recipient of the Martin Luther King award for his recruitment efforts and received a commendation from the Florida Human Relations Commission. He died on February 8, 1984, after succumbing to multiple sclerosis.
