Relief of Wanda Ray

BILL NO. AND SPONSOR:

I. SUMMARY:

On June 6, 1985, Wanda Ray was in the left turn lane of a major highway intersection when she was rear ended by a D.O.T. dump truck. Mrs. Ray sustained permanent soft tissue injuries of the neck and back resulting in a permanent partial disability of 5% of the whole person. She has sustained a loss of wage earning capacity of between 35 and 40%. Mrs. Ray and her husband filed suit against D.O.T. in 1987. A trial resulted in a judgement in favor of the Rays for \$209,000. D.O.T. paid \$100,000, leaving \$109,000 as the excess judgement claim asserted by the bill.

II. ECONOMIC IMPACT AND FISCAL NOTE:

The bill asserts a claim for \$109,000 to be paid by D.O.T.

III. COMMENTS:

The Special Master recommends that the bill be amended to provide an award to Wanda Ray of \$60,000, and that the bill be reported favorably as amended.

IV. AMENDMENTS:

#1 by Finance, Taxation, and Claims: Reduces the amount to be paid to Wanda Ray from \$109,000 to \$60,000.

#2 by Finance, Taxation, and Claims: Title amendment to accompany amendment #1.
