7.1 IN TEXT

Spell out the terms but not the numbers.

If the governor dies, article III, section 3, subsection a of the Florida Constitution provides that the lieutenant governor becomes governor.

7.2 IN FOOTNOTES

Use roman numerals for the article number, arabic numerals for the section number, (regardless of the form used by the original source), and large and small capital letters for the phrase "Fla. Const."
